AMTRAK REFORM AND AUTHORIZATION

Committee on Rules: Granted, by a vote of 8 to 3 a rule providing for the consideration of S. 738, Amtrak Reform and Accountability Act of 1997, which shall be considered as read. The rule provides that the amendment printed in the Rules Committee report shall be considered as adopted. The rule waives all points of order against the bill as amended. The rule also provides for one hour of debate equally divided and controlled by the Chairman and ranking minority member of the Committee on Transportation and Infrastructure. Finally the rule provides one motion to commit with or without instructions. Testimony was heard from Chairman Shuster and Representatives Oberstar and Wise.

Conferees agreed to file a conference report on the differences between the Senate- and House-passed versions of S. 830, to amend the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act and the Public Health Service Act to improve the regulation of food, drugs, devices, and biological products.
