## PERSONAL EXPLANATION

REPORT ON RESOLUTION PROVIDING FOR CONSIDERATION OF H. RES. 463, ESTABLISHING THE SELECT COMMITTEE ON U.S. NATIONAL SECURITY AND MILITARY/COMMERCIAL CONCERNS WITH THE PEOPLE'S REPUBLIC OF CHINA
