Committee on the Budget: On Friday, February 11, committee continued hearings on the President's proposed budget request for fiscal year 2001, receiving testimony from Madeleine K. Albright, Secretary of State.

Bills Introduced: 7 public bills, H.R. 3647–3653, and 1 private bill, H.R. 3654, were introduced.

Suspensions: The House agreed to suspend the rules and pass the following measures:

National Donor Day: H. Con. Res. 247, expressing the sense of Congress regarding the importance of organ, tissue, bone marrow, and blood donation and supporting National Donor Day (agreed to by a yea and nay vote of 379 yeas with none voting “nay”, Roll No. 16); and Pages H352–56, H358–59

Child Abuse and Neglect: H. Con. Res. 76, recognizing the social problem of child abuse and neglect, and supporting efforts to enhance public awareness of it (agreed to by a yea and nay vote of 378 yeas with none voting “nay”, Roll No. 17).

Recess: The House recessed at 2:43 p.m. and reconvened at 6:15 p.m. Page H358

Mexico-United States Interparliamentary Group: The Chair announced the Speaker's appointment of Representative Kolbe to the Mexico-United States Interparliamentary Group. Page H358
