Measures Passed:

National Girl Scout Week: Senate agreed to S. Res. 225, designating the week of March 10 through March 16, 2002, as “National Girl Scout Week”. **Page S1734**

National Safe Place Week: Committee on the Judiciary was discharged from further consideration of S. Res. 218, designating the week beginning March 17, 2002, as “National Safe Place Week”, and the resolution was then agreed to. **Pages S1734–35**

Energy Policy Act: Senate resumed consideration of S. 517, to authorize funding for the Department of Energy to enhance its mission areas through technology transfer and partnerships for fiscal years 2002 through 2006, taking action on the following amendments proposed thereto: **Pages S1715–26**
