Routine Proceedings, pages S1719–S1783

Measures Introduced: Six bills and two resolutions were introduced, as follows: S. 2731–2736, S. Res. 476, and S. Con. Res. 70. **Page S1741**

Measures Reported:

H.R. 1195, to amend the Safe, Accountable, Flexible, Efficient Transportation Equity Act: A Legacy for Users to make technical corrections, with an amendment in the nature of a substitute.

S. Con. Res. 70, setting forth the congressional budget for the United States Government for fiscal year 2009 and including the appropriate budgetary levels for fiscal years 2008 and 2010 through 2013.

Measures Passed:

Higher Education Extension Act: Senate passed S. 2733, to temporarily extend the programs under the Higher Education Act of 1965. **Page S1782**

Greek Independence Day: Senate agreed to S. Res. 476, designating March 25, 2008, as “Greek Independence Day: A National Day of Celebration of Greek and American Democracy”. **Page S1782**

Appointments:

Public Interest Declassification Board: The Chair, on behalf of the Majority Leader, pursuant to Public Law 106–567, the Intelligence Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2001, appointed the following individual to serve as a member of the Public Interest Declassification Board: Sanford Ungar of Maryland. **Page S1782**

Budget Resolution—Agreement: A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that Senate begin consideration of S. Con. Res. 70, Budget Resolution, at approximately 3 p.m., on Monday, March

10, 2008, and that there be debate only and that no amendments be in order. **Page S1781**

A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that Committee on the Budget have until 4 p.m., on Friday, March 7, 2008, to file the concurrent budget resolution, notwithstanding an adjournment of the Senate. **Page S1781**

Consumer Product Safety Modernization Act—Agreement: A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that, notwithstanding the March 6, 2008 passage, of H.R. 4040, Consumer Product Safety Modernization Act, Pryor (for Snowe) Amendment No. 4143, of a technical nature, which was previously agreed to, be modified. **Page S1781**
