Reports Filed: Reports were filed today as follows:

H.R. 6225, to amend title 38, United States Code, relating to equitable relief with respect to a State or private employer, with amendments (H. Rept. 110-778);

H.R. 6193, to require the Secretary of Homeland Security to develop and administer policies, procedures, and programs to promote the implementation of the Controlled Unclassified Information Framework applicable to unclassified information that is homeland security information, terrorism information, weapons of mass destruction information and other information within the scope of the information sharing environment established under section 1016 of the Intelligence Reform and Terrorism Prevention Act of 2004 (6 U.S.C. 485), with an amendment (H. Rept. 110-779);

H.R. 6073, to provide that Federal employees receiving their pay by electronic funds transfer shall be given the option of receiving their pay stubs electronically (H. Rept. 110-780);

H.R. 6113, to amend title 44, United States Code, to require each agency to include a contact telephone number in its collection of information, with amendments (H. Rept. 110-781);

H.R. 6322, to amend the District of Columbia Reform Act of 1995 to permit the District of Columbia government to exercise authority over the Public Charter School Board in the same manner as the District government may exercise authority over other entities of the District government (H. Rept. 110-782); and

H.R. 1338, to amend the Fair Labor Standards Act of 1938 to provide more effective remedies to victims of discrimination in the payment of wages

on the basis of sex, with an amendment (H. Rept. 110-783). Pages H7168-69
