Measures Introduced: Eight bills and two resolutions were introduced, as follows: S. 1414–1421, and S. Res. 238–239. **Page S4911**

Measures Passed:

Christopher S. Bond United States Courthouse: Senate passed S. 846, to designate the United States courthouse located at 80 Lafayette Street in Jefferson City, Missouri, as the Christopher S. Bond United States Courthouse. **Pages S4914–15**

Myron Donovan Crocker United States Courthouse: Committee on Environment and Public Works was discharged from further consideration of S. 1406, to designate the United States courthouse under construction at 510 19th Street, Bakersfield, California, as the Myron Donovan Crocker United States Courthouse, and the bill was then passed. **Page S4915**

Flood Insurance Reform Act—Agreement: A unanimous-consent agreement was reached providing that H.R. 1309, to extend the authorization of the national flood insurance program, to achieve reforms to improve the financial integrity and stability of the program, and to increase the role of private markets in the management of flood insurance risk, be discharged from the Committee on Banking, Housing and Urban Affairs, and that it be returned to the House of Representatives, pursuant to their Message on July 25, 2011, requesting its return. **Page S4915**
