Reports Filed: Reports were filed today as follows:

H. Res. 537, providing for consideration of the bill (H.R. 1734) to decrease the deficit by realigning, consolidating, selling, disposing, and improving the efficiency of Federal buildings and other civilian real property, and for other purposes (H. Rept. 112–385);

H.R. 1864, to limit the authority of States to tax certain income of employees for employment duties performed in other States, with an amendment (H. Rept. 112–386); and

H.R. 1162, to provide the Quileute Indian Tribe Tsunami and Flood Protection, and for other purposes, with an amendment (H. Rept. 112–387).

FAA Reauthorization and Reform Act—Conference Report: The House agreed to the conference report to accompany H.R. 658, to amend title 49,

United States Code, to authorize appropriations for the Federal Aviation Administration for fiscal years 2011 through 2014, to streamline programs, create efficiencies, reduce waste, and improve aviation safety and capacity, and to provide stable funding for the national aviation system, by a yeas-and-nays vote of 248 yeas to 169 nays, Roll No. 33.

H. Res. 533, the rule providing for consideration of the conference report, was agreed to by voice vote after the previous question was ordered without objection.

Baseline Reform Act of 2012: The House passed H.R. 3578, to amend the Balanced Budget and Emergency Deficit Control Act of 1985 to reform the budget baseline, by a yeas-and-nays vote of 235 yeas to 177 nays, Roll No. 32. Consideration of the measure began yesterday, February 2nd.

Rejected the Tierney motion to recommit the bill to the Committee on the Budget with instructions to report the same back to the House forthwith with an amendment, by a yeas-and-nays vote of 177 yeas to 238 nays, Roll No. 31.

H. Res. 534, the rule that is providing for consideration of the bills (H.R. 3578) and (H.R. 3582), was agreed to yesterday, February 2nd.
